Updated Policies and Procedures for MTAT Students

- Students must have a completed MTAT health screening form on file prior to attending class. Do not come to class or to a scheduled tutoring session if sick, experiencing any symptoms associated with COVID-19, or have been in close contact with anyone who has a laboratory confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19. In order to safely and responsibly reopen, and to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, we are asking that students follow the same procedures as our employees:
 - a. If you have new or worsening symptoms of COVID-19, you must inform MTAT, refrain from entering the classroom, and not return until you meet the following criteria:
 - *i.* If a student is diagnosed with COVID-19, the student may return to class when all three of the following criteria are met: at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the student has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; or
 - *ii.* In the case of a student who has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and does not get evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, the student is assumed to have COVID-19, and the student may not return to class until the individual has completed the same three-step criteria listed above; or
 - *iii.* If the student has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and wants to return to class before completing the above self-isolation period, the student must obtain a medical professional's note clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis.
 - b. If a student has been in close contact with anyone who has a suspected or laboratory confirmed COVID-19 case, the student must notify MTAT, refrain from entering the classroom, and may not return to class until the end of the 14 day self-quarantine period from the last date of exposure.
- 2. MTAT reserves the right to turn away students who are running a fever.
- 3. Practice safe social distancing (6 feet apart) from other students (excluding those in the same household) and MTAT staff when possible.
- 4. Under order no. 20200617-014 by the Mayor of the City of Austin, and to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19, all students are required to wear a face covering in our facility at least through August 15th, 2020.
- 5. Sanitize hands upon entry.
- 6. To minimize the number of people in the office at a time, and to minimize any congestion in the entryway, students must be picked up and dropped off outside of the building.
- 7. Students will be dismissed by the teacher in an orderly fashion.
- 8. Eating is prohibited in the classroom and in any common areas.
- 9. Students may bring water from home if it is in a container with a closed lid. The use of the MTAT water cooler/fountain is prohibited.
- 10. If you become sick or are running a fever, please report to MTAT staff, go or stay home, and follow proper guidelines on returning to class after becoming ill as listed in item 1, above.
- 11. Only students enrolled in a class, whose name appears on the class roster, and who have a completed health screening form on file will be permitted into the classroom.
