SAT Student Responsibilities

Our SAT course will prepare you for the SAT, a test that plays a significant role in your admission into college. Since the test is so important, preparation for it must be a priority. In order to be successful in this program and to be eligible for the money back guarantee, you must complete these minimum requirements:

- 1. Attend every class
 - 1. Arrive on time and ready to participate
 - 2. Stay until dismissed
 - 3. Bring your study binder (provided on your first day), testing device, a pen or pencil, and a calculator to every class and practice test.
- 2. Complete and log ALL of the assigned homework before class. Fill out the progress grid on the back of the stamp sheet.
- 3. Take at least one practice test during the course and before your official test (For best results, we recommend taking more than one.).
- Each SAT student should sign up for the official SAT online at collegeboard.org before the designated deadline. WE CANNOT DO THIS FOR YOU. Register with your high school counselor to take the PSAT.
